Georgia PGA Professional Patrick Richardson Elected to the PGA Board of Directors

New District 13 Director to Represent the Georgia, North Florida and South Florida PGA Sections

PALM BEACH GARDENS, Fla. (Nov. 11, 2016) – Patrick Richardson, PGA Head Golf Professional at Wilmington Island Club in Savannah, Georgia, has joined the PGA Board of Directors as District 13 Director. He was elected to the Board of Directors today at the 100th PGA Annual Meeting, as the Association celebrates its Centennial in New York City, where the PGA was founded in 1916. Richardson will serve a three-year term, representing the Georgia, North Florida and South Florida PGA Sections.

Richardson has served as the Head PGA Professional at Wilmington Island Club since 1999. With a long history of outstanding service, he has volunteered in several capacities of governance as a PGA member, including the Officer roles of Honorary President, President, Vice President and Secretary of the Georgia PGA Section from 2006-2014. Richardson also served on the National Member Benefits Committee Member from 2008-2016.

"The PGA of America is led by some of the most talented PGA Professionals in the world, who volunteer to serve as members of the PGA of America Board of Directors," said newly elected PGA President Paul Levy. "It is an honor to serve alongside these dynamic leaders, whose expertise will help guide the PGA, as we embark on the next chapter in the history of our storied Association."

Complementing his leadership roles for the Georgia PGA Section, Richardson previously served as the President of the Savannah Junior Golf Association (2003-2005), a Board member for the Georgia Junior Golf Foundation (2002-2003), and as a local middle school golf and basketball coach.

Richardson has received many awards and accolades during his tenure as a PGA Member, including being recognized as the Georgia PGA Section Golf Professional of the Year in 2011, the Georgia PGA Section Junior Golf Leader Award in 2002 and the Georgia PGA Section Assistant of the Year in 1999. An accomplished player, Richardson was honored as the Georgia PGA East Chapter Player of the Year on five occasions from 2004-2011.

"Becoming a member of the PGA of America was a dream that has evolved into a truly fulfilling experience, as the Association continues to help shape the future of the golf business," said Richardson. "I am fortunate to have this amazing opportunity to represent PGA Professionals across Georgia, Florida, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands at the National level of the Board of Directors."

Richardson earned a bachelor's degree in Business Management from Valdosta State University in 1994.

The PGA Board of Directors is composed of the Association's president, vice president, secretary, honorary president, and 17 directors. The directors include representatives from each of the PGA's 14 districts, two Independent Directors and a member of the PGA Tour. New District Directors are elected by their local PGA Sections.



PLEASE DO NOT USE ON GOLF COURSE
Golf Attire is Required

*RANGE SAFETY-PLEASE BE AWARE OF PLAYERS ON #1 GREEN AND #18 TEE. PLEASE AVOID HITTING CLUBS THAT WILL REACH EITHER AREA. MEMBERS THAT MAY HIT THE BALL TOWARDS TO THE LEFT SIDE OF RANGE PLEASE WAIT FOR PLAYERS TO CLEAR #1 GREEN BEFORE RESUMING PRACTICE. MEMBERS THAT MAY HIT THE BALL 240 YARDS OR MORE MUST SWITCH CLUBS WHILE PLAYERS TEE OF ON #18.

**HIT BETWEEN THE YELLOW ROPES FOR SAFETY AND CONSIDERATION OF OTHERS

*MATS ONLY (IRONS AND WOODS) ON WEDNESDAY AND FRIDAY

What are the green posts near the golf cart paths?

Carts must be kept on cart paths around the tees and greens at all times. When carts are permitted on fairways, they must follow exit post rules. Golf carts are to exit the fairways at the exit post near the cart path. The exit post will be a green post with a white top.

JANUARY TENNIS TIP.... "Try to hit shots in your Power Zone"

Your power zone for your forehand and backhand is between your knees and chest, approximately two feet away from your body. Hitting balls in this zone will allow you to add the most control, spin and power. During a match the main reason that you will hit balls in your power zone will be your footwork.

Through footwork (making split-steps, taking little steps and a quick recovery) you can change different types of balls (high, low and wide) to shots that you will hit in your power zone. Keep your feet moving and consistently hit balls in this zone to turn the power on.
