Did you know ...

By the Fall of 1621 only half of the pilgrims who had sailed on the Mayflower survived. Those survivors, thankful to be alive decided to give a thanksgiving feast.

The first Thanksgiving feast was held in the presence of around ninety Wampanoag Indians and the Wampanoag chief, Massasoit, was also invited there.

The first Thanksgiving Feast lasted three days.

The drink that the Puritans brought with them in the Mayflower was the beer.

Congress passed an official proclamation in 1941 and declared that now onwards Thanksgiving will be observed as a legal holiday on the fourth Thursday of every November.

DRIVING RANGE RULES

*GOLF ATTIRE IS REQUIRED

*RANGE BALLS FOR PRACTICE TEE AREA ONLY, PLEASE DO NOT USE ON GOLF COURSE

*RANGE SAFETY-PLEASE BE AWARE OF PLAYERS ON #1 GREEN AND #18 TEE. PLEASE AVOID HITTING CLUBS THAT WILL REACH EITHER AREA. MEMBERS THAT MAY HIT THE BALL TOWARDS TO THE LEFT SIDE OF RANGE PLEASE WAIT FOR PLAYERS TO CLEAR #1 GREEN BEFORE RESUMING PRACTICE. MEMBERS THAT MAY HIT THE BALL 240 YARDS OR MORE MUST SWITCH CLUBS WHILE PLAYERS TEE OFF ON #18.

**HIT BETWEEN THE YELLOW ROPES FOR SAFETY AND CONSIDERATION OF OTHERS

*MATS ONLY (IRONS AND WOODS) ON WEDNESDAY AND FRIDAY

*GUEST OF MEMBERS-CHARGE OF \$8 FOR USE OF THE RANGE-PLEASE SIGN IN THE GOLF SHOP FOR USE OF THE RANGE BY A GUEST. THIS POLICY IF FOR PRACTICE ONLY, THERE IS NOT A CHARGE FOR RANGE BALLS IF PLAYING GOLF

Golf Tip from the Pro

Short game practice routine



During the winter months, practicing your short game is an important step to improving your scores. I constantly see more members on the practice tee than the putting/chipping greens. I would suggest being different than others and moving more of your time to the short game area. Spend about 50% of your practicing time working on putting, chipping and bunker shots. Typically, most 18 handicap golfers waste about 5-8 shots per round due to short game mistakes. It's possible to hit your target score with extra time working on your short game and eliminating the mistakes on/around the greens.

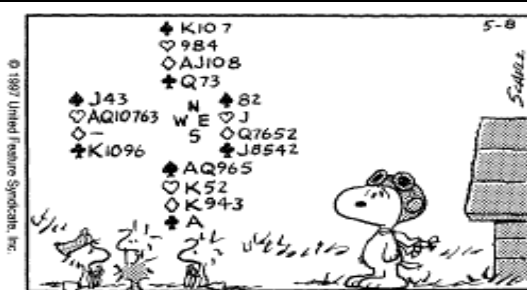
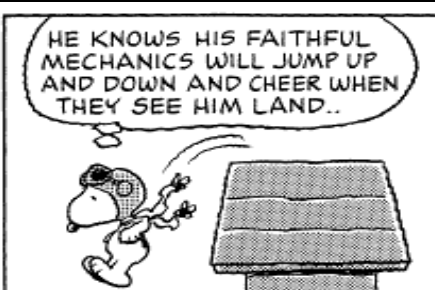

All guests **MUST** be signed in.

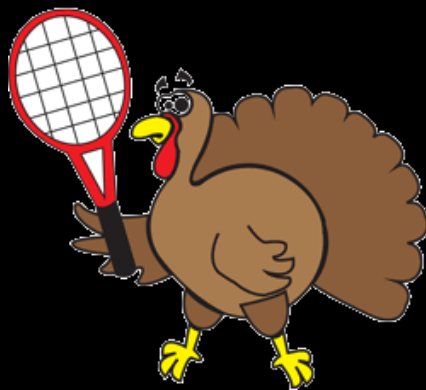

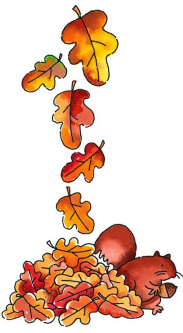
